

Financial Assistance to the 2002 CEA Meetings at Calgary

The CEA hopes that there will be SSHRC funds available for travel assistance to the 2002 CEA Meetings at Calgary. Official notification of the SSHRC award and the dollars available will not come until the Spring of 2002.

The CEA only provides partial travel assistance and applicants should be prepared to fund some travel themselves. **Funds will only be available to those located in North America and a strong preference will be given to Canadian applicants.** Individuals located outside of North America should not apply.

Eligibility for a travel grant is requires being a currently (2002) paid-up member of the Canadian Economics Association. Individuals may apply for financial assistance now and must be a CEA member at the time of the Meetings in June. Assistance will not be provided unless the application is supported by a signed statement from an appropriate person (e.g. department chair) indicating that travel funds are not available from the member's "employer".

You can download the travel grant included here. Send the completed grant application to me by fax or mail.

On April 20th, I shall take all travel grant applications I have received, and I shall provide assistance to persons giving papers. of those giving papers, first priority will go to graduate students; second to junior faculty; and third to senior faculty. Individuals will be notified by e-mail and by mail. Successful applicants will receive payment after the Meetings.
