

Financial Assistance to the 2005 CEA Meetings at McMaster University

The Canadian Economics Association, with the financial support of the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council, provides travel assistance to a limited number of participants in the annual meetings of the Canadian Economics Association. Please note that CEA travel grants only cover part of the cost of travel to the meetings, and successful applicants should still expect to incur some additional travel costs.

The number of travel grants given will depend upon the level of funding that the CEA receives from the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council. SSHRC funds, and hence the number of travel grants available, will not be confirmed until April, 2005.

The following criteria are used to determine who will receive travel grants:

- Grants will only be given to individuals who are current (2005) members of the Canadian Economics Association. If you are not currently a member, you must join before the CEA meetings in May.
- Grants will only be given to individuals who are presenting a paper or participating in a poster session at the CEA meetings.
- Priority is given to Canadian applicants. Individuals located outside of North America should not apply.
- Priority is given first to graduate students and second to junior faculty and faculty at smaller universities.
- Priority is given to those who have no other source of funds to finance travel to the CEA meetings.
